

Home Bound Service Policy

Home Bound Service is offered to the residents of Cranbury who are not able to come to the library for an extended period of time, for reasons including but not limited to bed-rest surgery recovery, inability to drive or walk to the Library, and the birth or adoption of an infant. All requests for Home Bound Service are subject to the approval of the Library Director.

Members requesting home bound service must have a current library card in good standing or be eligible to obtain one.

Delivery and pickup of library materials is offered on an as-needed basis, by appointment. Appointment times are dependent on the availability of staff to make deliveries to the home of the patron. Deliveries may be made on the way to/from a work shift at the library, or during work hours if there is sufficient staff coverage.

Delivery and pick up will not be completed if there is no one at the residence.

Home Bound Service may be terminated at any time for any reason.
